Vide reference cited above, the petitioner pointed out the following lapses in trace out the Missing persons and Identification unknown dead bodies by the Police.


The Police are depositing the unknown dead bodies in Osmania and Gandhi Hospital Mortuaries and their photos are not published anywhere in print media or electronic media, which should publish continuously for three days for identification purpose as per Police Act.

Every month, number of 'suspicious deaths' are recording under section 174 Cr. P.C and the unclaimed bodies are depositing in the mortuaries. Several of them, then go missing. Investigation into such disappearances are often kept pending for years.

All the SHOs of Rachakonda are instructed to "Utilize the services of SATYA HARISCHANDRA FOUNDATION, which is creating single platform to trace – out the unknown dead bodies of all the Police Stations.

Further all Inspector of Police L&O are instructed to pay their personal attention trace out Missing persons in Missing cases and in 174 Cr. P.C. cases.
