Sub : Mulugu District – Instructions to the SHOs regarding utilization of services by SATYA HARISCHANDRA FOUNDATION in identifying the unidentified dead bodies and missing persons before turning into unclaimed dead bodies – Issuance – Regarding

Vide reference cited above instructions are issued to utilize the services of Satya Harishchandra Foundation in tracing out the unidentified dead bodies and missing persons. Wherein, the founder pointed out the following lapses in tracing out the missing persons and identifying unknown dead bodies by the police.

The Police are depositing the unknown dead bodies in Osmania and Gandhi Hospital Mortuaries and their photos are not published anywhere in print media or electronic media, which should published continuously for three days for identification purpose as per Police Act.

Every month, many suspicious deaths are recording under section 174 Cr.P.C and the unclaimed bodies are deposited in the mortuaries and some of them go missing. Investigation into such disappearances are often kept pending for years.

Therefore all the SHOs are instructed to utilize the services of Satya Harishchandra Foundation which is creating single platform to trace out the unknown dead bodies of all Police Stations.
