Introduction:



Satya Harishchandra Foundation started by Mr. K. Rajeshwar Rao in the year 1994and formally established as a society in the year 2004 and registered vide Registration no. 1033/2001 under the Andhra Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 2001. Before dealing with the project proposal in detail, let us introduce ourselves and our activities in detail.

K. Rajeshwar Rao was a shutterbug and his photography services were utilised by Police Department in the Osmania General Hospital morgue to extract the photographs of unidentified dead bodies. He noticed the difficulties of persons to identify the dead bodies at mortuary. Hundreds of dead bodies are piled up in the mortuary and thought to create a single platform to trace out the identity of unidentified dead bodies. Accordingly, Mr. Rao has started preserving the photographs of dead bodies and started uploading in <u>www.unknownbodies.org</u> for further identification.

Main Objective of the SHF

- 1. To trace out identity of missing persons among the unidentified dead bodies and unknown patients in Government Hospitals.
- 2. To trace the identity of inmates of different old age homes by receiving missing complaints directly from individuals and look out notices from Police personnel.
- 3. To provide the dignified departure to unknown and unclaimed dead bodies.
- 4. To provide the shelter to shelter less Old Age Persons at different old age homes in the city including Satya Harishchandra Foundations Destitute Welfare Centre.
- 5. To make sure the transparency among the works of concerned officials dealing with unidentified dead bodies.

Ultimately, Satya Harishchandra Foundation aims at tracing-out the unidentified dead body within 3 days and dead body should be claimed by their respective family. Failing which can lead to mental trauma among the family members. In case of few other legal issues such as insurance, property claims, student scholarships or if any other statutory claim, the respective family has to wait till 7 years from the date of man missing FIR, to claim the civil death certificate from court. By the time, there will no assurance for the sustenance of dependent family.

Executive Members of Satya Harishchandra Foundation

Shri K. Rajeshwar Rao, Founder and Gen. Secretary, SHF brings the voice and eyes of human dignity to the process of serving the Society in the area of tracing the unidentified dead bodies and missing persons and also by providing dignified departure to unknown dead bodies. Shri K. Rajeshwar Rao, a native from Hyderabad, he is a shutterbug and in 1994 he got an opportunity to click the pictures of unidentified dead bodies at Govt. Hospital Mortuaries. Later he understood the difficulties in identifying the decomposed dead bodies. Hence, decided to provide the single platform to trace out the missing one among the unidentified dead bodies even after late hours of cremation by preserving their pictures– the result of said decision is SATYA HARISHCHANDRA FOUDNATION.

She hails from Hyderabad, She worked as Principal of Degree women's College, a unit of Agrawal Institutions having an experience around 30 years in teaching. She started working with Satya Harishchandra Foundation since 1 year.

She is a MBA Graduate, MA (Psychology), Pursuing Ph.D Psychology. Now, she is working as HR in a Pvt Limited Company. Started working with Satya Harishchandra Foundation since 3 years.

Harishchandra Foundation with complete passion. He is associated with SHF since 2015.



Result of Satya Harishchandra Foundation for the last 10 years:

Satya Harishchandra Foundation has created a single platform through website <u>www.unknownbodies.org</u>. As on 18.05.2021, our website consist of 15,326 updates of unidentified dead bodies, 3,189 photographs of unknown patients and 5,661 photographs of missing persons.

Cremation of 13500 above unknown dead bodies and providing shelter to hundreds of unknown patients from Government hospital, at different old age homes and tracing out of 5500 above identified dead bodies even after late hours of cremation and tracing of 1500 above unknown patients will stands as a testimony of our services.

Satya Harishchandra Foundation's Destitute Welfare Centre:

Satya Harishchandra Foundation frequently shift's the unknown patients from Government Hospitals to different old age homes to for shelter. And also felt the necessity to start a separate shelter home for destitute. Accordingly, in the year 2015, SHF started old age home called <u>Satya Harishchandra Foundation's Destitute</u> <u>Welfare Centre</u> with following vision and Goal:

Vision: To provide due care the lives of the helpless, destitute and old Aged persons in the society and even those Aged persons neglected by the family and did not get proper care due to poverty, so that they can live as valued members in the society with a peace of mind before going to their eternal home.

Goal: To ensure a sound and friendly environment for the poor, helpless, Neglected and Old aged persons towards achieving a promising peaceful conditions for them fostering their physical, mental, social and spiritual development and wellbeing as well.

At present, our Destitute Welfare Centre is providing the services by ensuring all the facilities. The following are the facilities available at Satya Harishchandra Foundation's Destitute Welfare Centre:

- 1. Spacious Accommodation with cots
- 2. Nutritious Food
- 3. Frequent Health Check-up by Doctors.
- 4. 24/7 Care takers are available.
- 5. We make sure that treatment is provided to inmates as per their health conditions.
- 6. Emergency oxygen cylinder is kept ready in case of emergency.

Details of premises:

Satya Harishchandra Foundation's Destitute Welfare Centre is located at H. No. 10-153/A, Ashok Reddy Colony, Nadergul (V), Balapur (M), Ranga Reddy Dist., -510501. The present building is provided on lease by a donor for Rs. 1 for the period of 25 years.

Details of Donor as follows:

Smt. and Sri Dr. Shailaja Prasad (retired) Superintendent, Koti Maternity Hospital. She purchased the building out of her retrial benefits by adding some more money and provided building on lease for 25 years @ Rs. 1/-.

Number inmates as on 18.06.2022:

At present our old age home consists of 35 beds and 25 inmates are residing at destitute Welfare Centre suffering from multiple disorders like leprosy, mentally ill etc. All 25 inmates are under treatment based on their illness.

Recurring Expenses of Old Age Home:

- 1. Monthly Expenses
- 2. Food ingredients for inmates costing around Rs.32 K to 35 K $\,$
- 3. Electricity Charges– Rs. 8K to 9K
- 4. Water Bill Rs. 1500/- (We purchase water)
- 5. Milk Rs. 2700/-
- 6. Vegetables Rs. 6 K to 8K
- 7. Other miscellaneous expenses around Rs. 7000/- to Rs. 10,000/-.

The Destitute Welfare Centre will meet all these expenses through public donations.

PROJECT - PROPOSAL

<u>PROBLEM:</u>



On an average, for every 8 - 10 minutes -one person is missing in India. According to the women and child development ministry website for tracking missing children, every year at about 60,000 children are missing and it is very difficult to trace. Hyderabad city is one among those cities which is known for

opportunities and employments. To avail such opportunities, youth between 18 - 25 and other age groups of different cities in India are migrating to Hyderabad. On an average, only in Hyderabad, daily 6-15 persons are missing on daily basis.

Ours is an Organisation, working since 25 years in the above area to trace out the missing persons. But, to our utter surprise, missing ratio is more than death cases. Even in Lockdown period i.e., March 2020 to August 2020 total 1,011 Persons are gone missing only from Hyderabad, which is nothing but an alarming situation.

In the year, 2012 adding one more measure to our services, to trace-out the missing persons at early stage, SHF started NINGI NELA NEWS PAPER to publish the photographs of missing persons, unidentified dead bodies and unknown patients and will be sent to all police stations at free of cost. NINGI NELA NEWS PAPER is working as a lookout notice and creating single platform to the following 3 categories. The purport of the NNN Paper is to bring the every single photo of missing persons and unidentified dead bodies to a single platform and upload in Satya Harishchandra Foundation website www.unknownbodies.org

We are very much successful in collecting the above information along with the photograph from entire State of Telangana but we are lacking in tracing –out the unidentified dead bodies even after late hours of their respective disposal. After a detailed research we came to a conclusion that tracing ratio is less due to nonawareness among the general public about the services of Satya Harishchandra Foundation. To overcome the said grievance we made a resolution to start the News Channel.

Purpose of News Channel:

- 1. To publish the photographs of unidentified dead bodies, unknown patients and missing persons. Every photograph will scrolls for 3 days.
- 2. Also to publish the photographs of inmates residing at different old age homes until their reach the respective families.

To reunite those unfortunate persons with their respective families - Satya Harishchandra Foundation took a step to start news channel which works only for tracing of missing persons which includes all controlling measures of human trafficking. The details of project NINGI NELA NEWS CHANNEL, 2021-2022 is as follows:

Infrastructure required:

Total project cost is Rs. 25,00,000/- (Twenty Five Lakhs only). Initially we tried for donation in kind and able to gather below two computers and other required electronic gadgets of worth Rs.6,00,000/- (Six Lakhs Only).
